



Smith Family Scholarship Fund
Criteria effective with the Class of 2008

1. One-time scholarships shall be used to provide tuition and fees only (room and board not included) up to a maximum of \$1,000 for applicants who are graduated from Parkers Chapel High School (PCHS) after attending a minimum of four years completing grades 9-12;
2. There shall be no geographical limitations on the places of study as long as they are approved and/or accredited two or four year educational institutions;
3. Applicants must complete an application form made available through SHARE Foundation. The completed application shall be delivered to the Vice President for Administrative Services at SHARE Foundation, 403 West Oak Street, Suite 100, El Dorado, AR 71730;
4. Recipients must have maintained a 3.0 minimum grade point average while attending Parkers Chapel School;
5. Funds will be paid directly to the educational institution and cannot be stacked with other scholarships to pay more than the actual amount of tuition and fees;
6. A copy of the applicant's high school transcript must be attached;
7. A copy of the letter of acceptance into the educational institution or program of study must be submitted to SHARE Foundation prior to payment being made;
8. Applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours;
9. A minimum of two letters of recommendation must be attached. At least one must be from a PCHS teacher on PCHS letterhead;
10. Verification from Parkers Chapel School indicating the number of years the applicant attended a complete school year at Parkers Chapel School must be attached;
11. An essay of 500 words or less describing why applicant is applying for this scholarship must be attached;
12. Include one (1) original plus seven (7) copies of the completed application and attachments;
13. Application deadline is April 15.

SMITH FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND
GUIDELINES

March 17, 2008

NOW THEREFORE, this fund shall be administered in accordance with these established principles, subject to modification by SHARE Foundation as needed in the future to meet the general purposes of the fund. The guidelines are as follows:

1. Each scholarship awarded shall be named the Smith Family Scholarship.
2. Only the proceeds of the fund are to be used for scholarships. The original principal of the fund totaling \$45,000 shall be maintained for the purpose of generating income for the scholarships.
3. The intent of the scholarship is to assist qualifying students who have financial need.
